

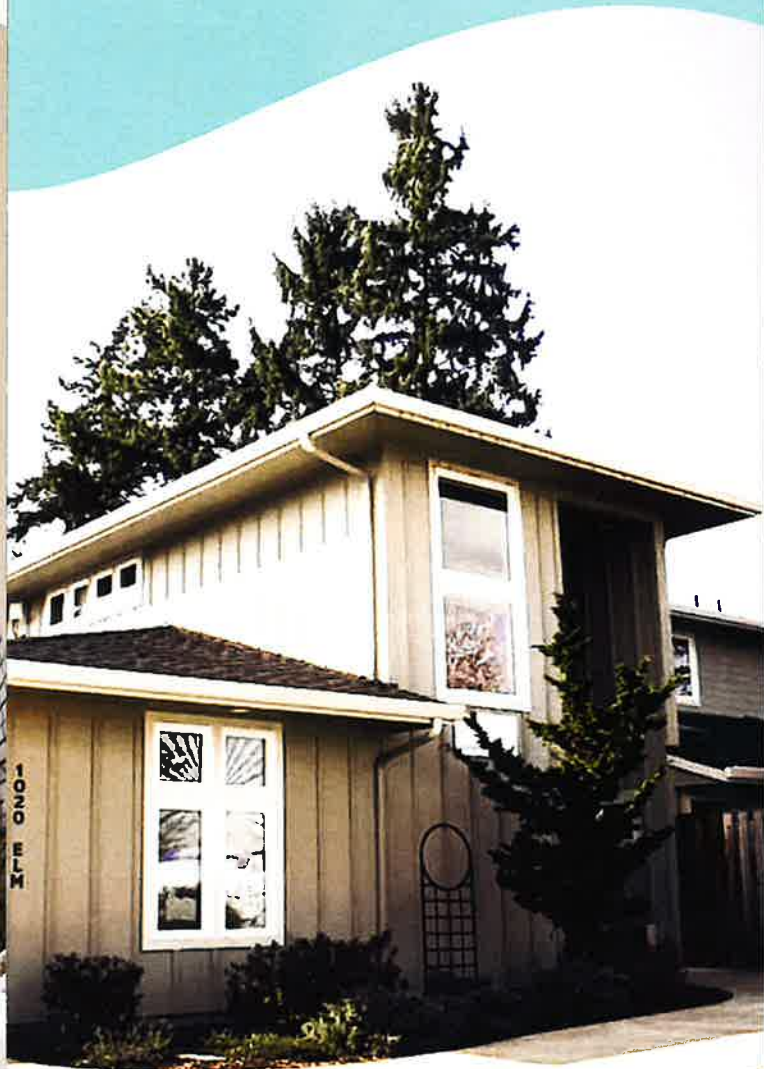

## TOKARSKI HOME

*The Edward F. Tokarski Home* is an option for WVH Hospice Care patients who need a place to call home in their final months of life.

- Individualized care provided for up to 5 residents
- Caregivers at the ready 24 hours a day
- All meals based on resident's needs and desires
- Unique staffing model with registered nurse manager and certified nursing assistants who have passed the hospice aide competency test
- Medicaid, private pay or philanthropic care when needed
- Licensed as a class 3 adult foster home by the state of Oregon
- Located at 1020 Elm Street NW, adjacent to Willamette Vital Health administrative offices
