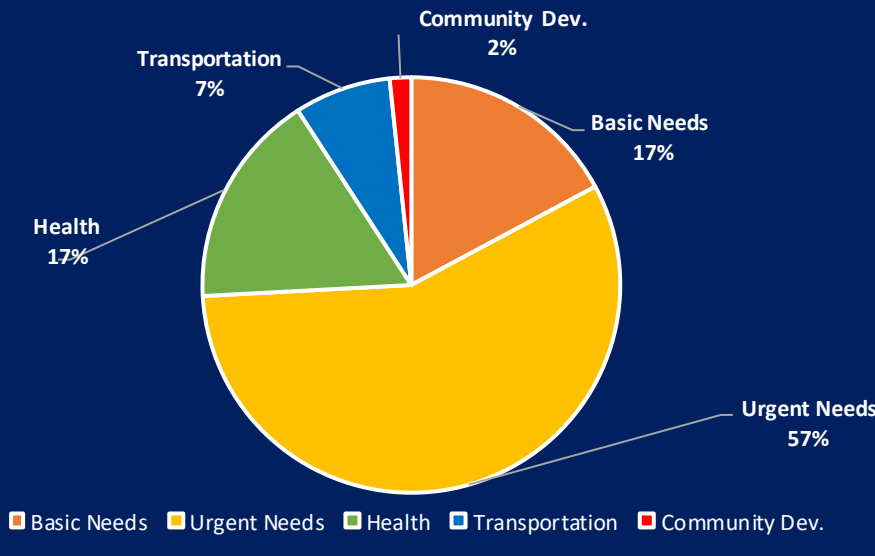

Needs Identified, Vetted, and Approved by the team:

- A wildfire survivor now has safe water to drink with a new well.
- A veteran has a new lift chair that will assist him in gaining some independence back after a long history of diabetes and loss of a limb.
- A teen mom was able to provide her baby with the necessary items it takes to care for a newborn.
- A senior was able to have her water turned on after not having it for three months. She now has water to drink, water to shower in, and water to clean her home.
