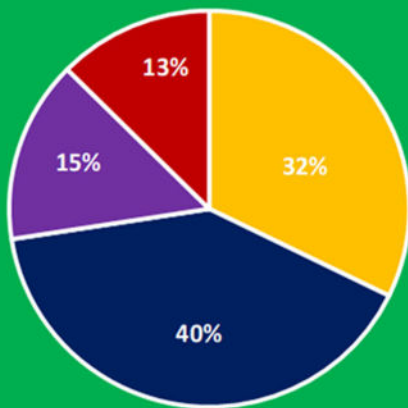

- A patient was able to have a special shoe ordered after being diagnosed with a wound that would not heal without the shoe.
- A community member with new employment was able to meet his the employer's dress code with appropriate clothing.
- A domestic violence survivor was able to relocate into a new home.
