The Weatherization Assistance Program offers income eligible individuals and families a long-lasting solution to reduce their electric, gas and water bills by making their homes healthier and more energy efficient. The program makes home improvements to protect your home from the elements, such as wind, sunlight, and rain.

## What are the benefits of weatherizing my home?

Residents who weatherize their homes typically end up with lower utility bills. The program improves health and safety by removing any energy-related hazards. These improvements add up over time and can be very beneficial for reducing energy use. Improving your energy efficiency can also improve the comfort of your home, your quality of life, and improve our environment.

## Potential weatherization measures

Eligible clients receive a comprehensive energy audit. During the audit, diagnostics tests are performed to determine potential cost-effective improvements.

Improvements may include:

- Attic, floor, or wall insulation
- Weatherstripping around doors
- Air Infiltration reduction
- Ventilation Fan
- Heating System evaluation
- Installation of carbon monoxide & smoke alarms
- Minor weatherization related repairs

## Energy Education

All qualified applicants are required to attend an energy education session where the following topics are discussed:

- Energy Saving Tips
- Health & Safety
- Water Conservation
- Home maintenance

## Steps of the Weatherization Program



### Pre-Screening Form

Fill out a pre-screening form.  
Call (503) 315-7055 for more info



### Intake Appointment

When you are next in line for services you will be contacted to set up an intake appointment to determine your eligibility for the program.



### Energy Education

Once eligibility is determined you will need to attend an energy education session.



### Energy Audit

An energy audit will be performed and the results will guide what kind of work will be done.



### Contractor Work

Contractors or program employees will perform approved energy saving measures.



### Final Inspection

A final inspection will be done to ensure everything is in working order.



### Maintenance

You must maintain the improvements to keep your home in working order. A one year warranty is offered on weatherization work.

## Eligibility Criteria

- Reside in Marion or Polk Counties
- Own/rent a site-built or manufactured home, duplex, triplex, fourplex  
*Renters will need property owner authorization prior to scheduling intake appointment.*
- Meet the federal income guidelines  
*Call our office for current guidelines*
- Provide all required documentation during intake appointment
