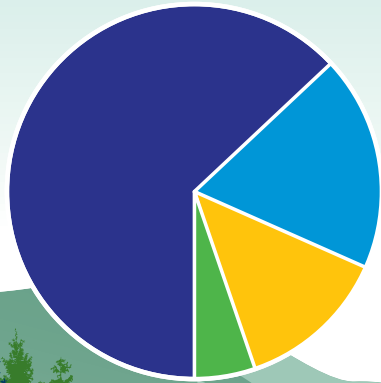
Team Dollars spent: **\$4,443.54**

A family of two adults and two children had experienced more than two years of housing instability, including couch-surfing with family and friends, before securing a rental in Aumsville. The SI Team approved funds to help cover the \$3,000 security deposit, allowing them to move into stable housing while the household income supported ongoing rent.

Following the birth of a premature infant, a family remained in Portland to be near their baby during treatment. Rent assistance from the Team helped keep their housing secure and provided peace of mind during a challenging time.

When a Veteran's family regained custody of a child, they needed help covering the costs of furniture, clothing, and school supplies. The team support helped the family meet these immediate needs and focus on building a strong foundation for their future.

A family of four spent more than two years without stable housing, relying on temporary arrangements with family and friends. When they found a rental home in Aumsville, the Team helped cover the security deposit, creating a pathway to long-term housing stability and a fresh start.
