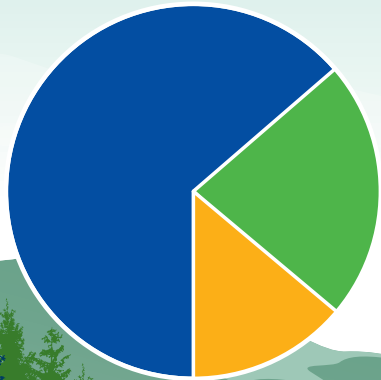


# North Santiam Integration Team 2025–2026 Report

North Santiam assisted  
**155** individuals through team dollars

A single mother left a domestic violence situation and needed help with a security deposit to find stable housing. With support from a team partner at ODHS, she and her children moved into stable housing, received a housing voucher, and got support for healing.

An adult without stable housing received assistance through SI Funds and support from Crossroads Communities to apply for an apartment. After being approved and moving into affordable housing, the individual achieved greater stability and independence, with continued support to connect to resources that promote long-term success.

An older adult with a disability needed help with rent after unexpected medical costs and a drop in benefits. His community health worker applied for funding, helped arrange an in-home caregiver, and connected him with NWSDS.

A couple staying in another family's mud room had a chance to move into an apartment but needed help with a deposit and first month's rent. The NS SI Team approved the request to cover the fees, and the couple moved into a home of their own.

A domestic violence survivor needed help with her electric bill after paying for legal fees and security cameras for her home. The Salvation Army and the North Santiam SI Team helped pay the balance and keep her power on.
