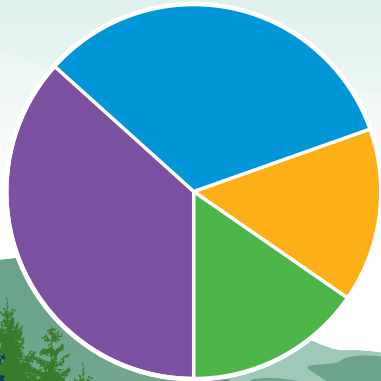


Scio Integration Team 2025–2026 Report

A community member escaping domestic violence needed to leave an unsafe environment quickly but had not yet secured permanent housing. While temporarily staying with family and at CARDV, she faced the challenge of safely storing her belongings as she worked toward stability. The SI Team approved funding for temporary storage, removing an immediate barrier and allowing her to focus on securing safe, permanent housing and rebuilding her life.

A newly employed father needed help with a security deposit and rent to secure housing. With support from neighbors, donations, and SI Team funding for critical housing costs, he established a stable home environment and was able to move forward with fostering a child.

When missed payments caused a patient's auto insurance to lapse, her family risked losing transportation needed for cancer treatment and work. The SI Team approved funding to reinstate coverage, removing an immediate barrier and helping the family maintain stability while longer-term support was arranged.

Following a domestic violence incident, a parent and children were forced to leave their home and temporarily stay with family. The SI Team provided gas assistance, ensuring access to medical, legal, school, and housing appointments while helping the family stay connected to vital support services during their transition to stability.
